



**Government schemes in India are to address the social and economic welfare of the citizens of this nation. These schemes play a vital role in solving many socio- economic problems that beset Indian society and thus their awareness is a must for any concerned citizen.**

**This booklet will help citizens, elected representatives and other functionaries to create awareness about different departmental schemes implemented by Government of Goa.**

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## SCHEMES OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT

### 1. National Social Assistance Programme

#### a) Indira Gandhi National Old Age Pension Scheme (IGNOAPS)

Indira Gandhi National Old Age Pension Scheme is a 100% Central Scheme covering the beneficiaries residing in rural areas and also from urban area comes under BPL category. Under this programme, pension of Rs.200/- per month to Senior Citizen and Rs.300/- per month to Disabled & Widow is provided to the beneficiaries of 60 years of age and above till the age of 79 years and thereafter Rs.500/-.

The beneficiary must be a destitute in the sense of having little or no regular means of subsistence from his/her own source of income or through financial support from family members or other sources. This scheme had been transferred to Directorate of Social Welfare along with the list of the beneficiaries. However, the pension of Rs.300/- to Rs.500/- per month is being given to the beneficiaries by the grant-in-aid, to Directorate of Social Welfare by this Agency. The Category wise breakup of the Pension is as follows:

#### b) National Family Benefit Scheme

Under the scheme, a lump sum grant (assistance) of Rs.20,000/- is being provided to the family on the death of its primary bread winner either male or female should have occurred while he or she is in the age group of 18 to 59 years, i.e., more than 18 years of age and less than 60 years of age. Earlier proposals in this respect were processed at Block Level and submitted to DRDA for sanction of assistance. However, in order to provide instant relief, the funds are placed at the disposal of respective BDO at Taluka level and he has been authorized to provide the assistance to the applicant. This scheme is 100% funded by the Central Government.

## **2. National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM)**

National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM) scheme was launched in the State of Goa on 19<sup>th</sup> December 2015 as Goa State Rural Livelihood Mission (GSRLM) sharing in the ratio of 60:40 between Centre and State respectively. National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM) is a poverty alleviation project focused on promoting self-employment and organization of rural poor. The basic idea behind this programme is to organize the poor into SHG (Self Help Groups) and make them capable for self-employment and skilled wage employment opportunities, resulting in appreciable increase in their incomes, on a sustainable basis.

## **3. Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA)**

This scheme was made applicable to the State of Goa w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2008. The objective of the scheme is to provide wage for the enhancement of livelihood security of the households in rural areas of the country by providing at least one hundred days of guaranteed wage employment in a financial year to every household whose adult members volunteer to do unskilled manual work at the statutory minimum wage. The wage is enhanced to Rs.280/- w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2020.

The expenditure over and above the approved pattern of Central assistance will be borne by the State. Hence, though the scheme is in the ratio of 90:10, due to commitment of difference in the amount of wages and administrative expenses the allocation of the State Government is more than 10%. Provision is to be made for unemployment allowance at the rate of 25% of the daily of Rs.280/- for the first 30 days and ½ (50%) of the wage rate (Rs.280/-) for remaining 70 days is to be borne by the State Government. Also, any other administrative expenses of 6% are to be borne by the State Government.

## **4. Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY)**

This scheme is a Central Scheme of which the primary objective is to provide connectivity by way of all weather roads (with necessary culverts and cross drainage structures, which is operable throughout the year) to the unconnected Habitations in rural areas in such a way that Habitations with a population of 1000 persons are covered in 3 years and all unconnected Habitations with a population of 500 persons above are covered in 7 years. Besides, the scheme also aims to upgrade the existing roads to desired specifications. The scheme is implemented through Public Work Development.

## **5. Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY)**

Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) is a centrally sponsored scheme sharing ratio i.e. 60:40 between Centre and State respectively. DDU-GKY is a part of the National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM), tasked with the dual objectives of adding diversity to the incomes of rural poor families and cater to the career aspirations of rural youth. This is a new scheme.

DDU-GKY is uniquely focused on rural youth between the ages of 15 and 35 years from poor families. As a part of the Skill India campaign, it plays an instrumental role in supporting the social and economic programs of the government like the Make In India, Digital India, Smart Cities and Start-Up India, Stand-Up India campaigns. Over 180 million or 69% of the country's youth population between the ages of 18 and 34

years, live in its rural areas. Of these, the bottom of the pyramid youth from poor families with no or marginal employment number about 55 million.

#### **6. Goa Gram Samrudhi Yojana (GGSY)**

This scheme provides creation of infrastructure assets in the rural areas such as Panchayat Ghars, Village Community Halls, Crematoriums, Rural Roads etc. and are carried out for the benefit of the rural people. Most of the works are taken up in tribal areas since there is a demand from the S.T. community. Many Panchayats have submitted their proposals for construction of new Panchayats since the premises are very old. This scheme is 100% funded by the State Government.

The maximum limit for works with the approval of the Committee constituted under GGSY should be Rs.25.00 lakhs (Rupees Twenty Five Lakhs only). Any works above the prescribed limit are to be approved by the Government for Administrative and Financial approval.

#### **7. Financial Assistance for New Domestic LPG Connection to BPL Families (Plan) – “Goa Grameen Urja Yojana (GGUY)”**

The objective of the scheme is to provide Below Poverty Line families installation of Domestic one new LPG connection, pollution free (Fuel) to minimize the use of firewood, thus reducing the pressure on forest and at the same time helping in maintaining pollution free environment as well health of housewife's. The BPL families are provided with free LPG installation comprising of one gas stove with two burners and two cylinders with all other required accessories for the total cost of Rs.6087/-. This scheme is 100% funded by the State Government.

#### **8. Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana (Gramin ) (PMAY-G)**

Indira Awaas Yojana (IAY) is now replaced as Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana -Gramin (PMAY-G) from the financial year 2016-17 and the beneficiary will now get Rs.1,20,000/- instead of Rs.95,000/-. Only for those whose names appear in the Socio-Economic Caste Census 2011 housing beneficiaries list i.e. 2619 persons all over Goa are eligible to avail the benefit under PMAY-G scheme.

These 2619 names were sent to the various Village Panchayats so that the names could be approved at their Gram Sabha Meetings. About approximately 1000 names were rejected at the various Gram Sabhas since some of the beneficiaries have constructed their houses on their own during the intermediate period from 2011 to 2015 and few beneficiaries were migrants and could not be traced comprising mostly of labour force.

#### **9. Rurban Mission Scheme**

Under Shyama Prasad Mukherji National Rurban Mission Scheme of Government of India under Phase I - One cluster of Xeldem Quepem in South Goa of which ICAP and DPR are approved by the Ministry of Rural Development. Under Phase II - Saligao cluster in Bardez Taluka is approved under the Scheme. The final ICAP of Saligao has been forwarded to the Ministry for approval and the State Technical Support Agency has been requested to expedite the preparation of DPR.

## Schemes of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services Department

### Kamdhenu Scheme (Sudharit) Amended.

#### ELIGIBILITY:-

- Any person residing in Goa for at least 05 years or more.
- Knowledge or experience in Cattle or Buffaloes farming.
- Land for green fodder cultivation desirable.
- Farmer who had availed the purchase of animals under the earlier Kamdhenu Scheme.
- Applicant should necessarily have a Cattle shed to undertake the scheme.

#### DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED:

- ♣ Residence Certificate from Mamlatdar/Sarpanch or Chairman of Dairy Society verified and attested by the Veterinary Officer/Assistant Director in charge of the area.
- ♣ Attested copy of Aadhar Card.
- ♣ Affidavit in prescribed format regarding ownership of Cattle Shed.
- ♣ Caste Certificate of SC/ST/Dhangar.
- ♣ Letter from financing institution having Electronic clearance system (ECS) willing to finance the beneficiary.
- ♣ Passport size photograph of the applicant

#### DETAIL GUIDELINES OF THE SCHEME:

- 1) The scheme intends to provide self-employment to the youth by assisting the youth or any person desirous in establishing a Dairy Farm. Under the Scheme the farmer can buy Cross Bred Cows/Improved She Buffaloes/ Indigenous breed cows namely Sahiwal, Gir and Red Sindhi in one to three phases.
- 2) The eligible applicant should purchase the sanctioned animals within one year of sanction of the scheme.
- 3) Unit cost of the Cross Bred Cow/Improved She Buffalo/ Indigenous breed cow namely Sahiwal, Gir and Red Sindhi shall be limited to Rs. 70,000/- per animal expected to yield 2700 liters of milk per lactation for the purpose of release of subsidy.
- 4) Subsidy on the cost of the animal shall be as follows:

5) Incentives towards transportation of the animals at the rate of Rs. 1500/- (Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred Only) per animal or actual cost of transportation, whichever is less for the purchase made outside the State and Rs. 600/- (Rupees Six Hundred Only) per animal or actual cost of transportation, whichever is less for the purchase made at cattle melas organized by the Department shall be reimbursed to the beneficiary's loan account through ECS along with subsidy amount.

6) Under the Scheme, a beneficiary can purchase either crossbred cows/improved She buffaloes/ Indigenous breed cows namely Sahiwal, Gir and Red Sindhi.

7) The farmer has to produce a letter from the financing institution having ECS system, willing to finance him.

8) All milch animals under the scheme have to be purchased from Cattle Mela organized by the Directorate of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, Govt. of Goa or from outside the State, accompanied by a Veterinary Doctor of the Department. In case of farmers permitted to purchase animals from outside the state, other than the Cattle Melas held by the Department in Goa, subject to following conditions:

- ♣ Fulfilling all the conditions laid as required under Kamdhenu Scheme (Sudharit) viz. a well constructed Cattle Shed with cement flooring, fodder cultivation etc.
- ♣ b) Each farmer is permitted to purchase Improved she Buffaloes/ Indigenous breed cows namely Sahiwal, Gir and Red Sindhi from outside the State other than the Melas held by the Department in Goa. Farmers who have availed any Govt. dairy scheme earlier as well as Traditional dairy farmers(fresh applicant) currently engaged in dairy business as well as fresh entrants who have undergone Dairy training are permitted to purchase 10 animals at a time in 1<sup>st</sup> phase from the Mela or outside the State only on recommendation of the local Area Officer.
- ♣ c) Obtain prior written permission well in advance from the Department before undertaking such purchase.
- ♣ d) Be a member of the Local Dairy Society/Bachat Gat/Self help groups.
- ♣ e) Purchase of animals from outside the State shall be done accompanied by local area Veterinary Doctor/ designated Veterinary Doctors panel of the Department.

9) The Veterinary Officer should ensure that details of purchase including microchip number should be faxed to this office on fax no. 0832-2437244 immediately within 24 hrs after affecting the purchase.

10) It shall be the sole responsibility of the beneficiary/ financing institution to insure the animals which include Transit Insurance which is mandatory and submit the proof of insurance or policy documents to the concerned Assistant Director/Veterinary Officer within a period of 07 days of purchase.

11) On purchase of animals the Officer accompanying the farmers for purchase of milch animals, has to submit the Purchase statement, purchase receipt, transport receipt, duly certified by the Area Veterinary Officer/Assistant Director, Bank official and the farmer along with insurance document, to financing institution.

12) The Purchase statement and documents as stated at '11' above shall be submitted to Head Office by the financial Institution within 2 weeks of effecting purchase so as to enable release of subsidy.

13) Identification of Kamdhenu animals must be done only through Microchips system. The existing Cross Bred Cows/Improved she Buffaloes / Indigenous breed cows namely Sahiwal, Gir and Red Sindhi shall be identified by microchip only.

14) Release of subsidy will depend on the receipt of the documents mentioned at clause (11) above, which should be submitted by the Financing Institution, and no relaxation will be considered.

15) Animals purchased under the Scheme should be insured for minimum period of a 3½ years under the Comprehensive Insurance Policy with such Insurance Agency/company as the Department may from time to time notify (approved by the Government). It shall be the sole responsibility of the beneficiary to insure the animals immediately on purchase. The Government shall not be responsible in the event of the death of the animal or otherwise. The respective Financing Institution shall be responsible for the tie up arrangement of insurance cover between the beneficiary and the insurance Company. The premium towards insurance including transit insurance should be initially borne by the beneficiaries /financing institution, the Department shall reimburse the premium amount to a maximum of Rs. 14455/- (Rupees Fourteen Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-Five Only) per animal directly to the financing institution, together with the subsidy amount on receipt of all the required documents in order.

16) The animals purchased under the Scheme cannot be disposed off for a minimum period of 3 ½ years. In case of default, Government "shall recover the subsidy amount paid to the beneficiary on pro -rata basis" from the amount of subsidy released and kept in financial institution as back ended subsidy.

17) a) In case of death of animal, outstanding loan amount pertaining to that animal shall be paid directly to the financing institution to the beneficiary's loan account from the death claim amount reimbursed by the insurance company and balance claim amount shall go to Government

b) In the event of unfortunate death of the animal within one month from date of purchase, beneficiary has to report in writing to Area officer and fax on 0832- 2437244 to the Deputy Director (Kamdhenu) within 24 hours of death. Pursuant of confirmation and verification of death by the said officers and on satisfying the officer that death is not due to negligence on the part of beneficiary, the cost of the animal shall be directly credited to the account of the beneficiary.

18) In the event of the animal undergoing permanent total Disability (PTD) after duly certified by team of experts appointed by Directorate of A. H. & V. S. for that purpose the farmer has option to dispose the animal under the intimation to Directorate of A.H. & V. S., Panaji – Goa.

19) In the event of animal yielding less than 50% of expected milk yield as stated at the time of purchase within 45 days from the date of calving, beneficiary has to report in writing to Area Officer and Fax on 0832-2437244 to the Director of Animal husbandry & Veterinary Services immediately. Pursuant of confirmation and verification of milk yield less than 50% of expected milk yield at the time of purchase by the said officer within 72 hours of intimation by farmer and on being satisfied by the Officer concerned that the milk yield is less than 50% of expected milk and is not due to negligence in feeding and management on the part of beneficiary, than the cost of the animals shall be directly credited to the loan account of the beneficiary. Such animal shall be the property of the Government and the beneficiary has to return the animal to the Government designated Farm at his own cost. Value of such animals shall be determined by the valuation committee appointed by the Department and the said animal is proposed to be returned to the seller for the price to be determined by the Departmental committee and the proceeds shall be deposited to Government Treasury by the Department. This is only applicable for the purchase of animals at Cattle Melas organized at Cattle Breeding Farm, Copardem/Dhat of this Directorate and not applicable for the animals purchased by the farmers from other States.

**PROCEDURE FOR APPLICATION: -**

1. The farmers interested in availing this facility will have to apply in a prescribed application form through Area Assistant. Director/Veterinary. Officer.
2. A non-refundable processing fee of Rs. 200/- (Rupees Two hundred only) and for SC/ST/Dhangar Rs. 25/- (Rupees Twenty-Five Only) shall be collected at the time of accepting the application at the respective Government Dispensary or Hospital.
3. On processing the cases (within 15 days) the Assistant Director/Veterinary Officer of the respective Hospital/Dispensary shall submit the application of all farmers eligible under the scheme to the Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services, for sanction by the Department.
4. Applications should be received in triplicate (Original plus 2 photocopies) along with all the documents as mentioned in guideline of the scheme. The following Documents are required to release the subsidy.
  - The prescribed Purchase statement should be certified and stamped by the Area Veterinary Officer/Assistant Director and Official of the Financing Institution and should be signed by the beneficiary.
  - Purchase and transport receipt should be attested with a stamp by the Area Veterinary Officer/Assistant Director and Official of the financing institution and beneficiary, which should be enclosed along with the purchase statement mentioned at 1 above.
  - Proof of Insurance should also be enclosed together with the purchase statement.
  - Agreement bond sworn before Notary/Magistrate on stamp paper as per rule in force in Departmental prescribed format.
  - Subsidy will then be released as per the pattern of the scheme.

## **INFRASTRUCTURE COMPONENT OF KAMDHENU SCHEME (SUDHARIT) AMENDED**

### **Financial Assistance:**

It is proposed to subsidize 80% of Construction cost for a cattle shed with an Area of 5.4 Sq. mtr. per animal and the construction cost @ Rs. 6000/- per sq. mtr. Unit could be of 10 Milch Animals limited to maximum of 20 Milch Animals.

This Infrastructure Component is linked to Kamdhenu scheme (Sudharit). Release of subsidy shall be linked to number of Milch Animals purchased, minimum 50% of the unit strength @ Rs. 25,920/- per animal, shall be released the benefit under Infrastructure component of Kamdhenu Scheme (Sudharit). Infrastructure subsidy shall be released after purchase of animals. Bank loan is compulsory.

### **DOCUMENT REQUIRED**

- 1) Copy of land ownership document.
- 2) Form I & XIV document.
- 3) Deed of lease for the period of 5 years/Notarized NOC Affidavit from Landlord to Tenant (Applicant) for a period of 5 years/Affidavit in Prescribed Format regarding ownership of cattle shed.
- 4) Survey Site plan.
- 5) Approved Cattle Shed plan from Government Authorized Engineer/Architect.
- 6) Copy of Bank Passbook/Mandate form from financial institution.
- 7) Construction License from prescribed authority.
- 8) Willingness from Bank/financing Institution ready to finance.

Documents required for release of Subsidy after completion of unit:

1. Valuation certificate from an Approved Valuer.
2. Occupancy Certificate from Panchayat/Municipality.
3. Receipts/Vouchers towards completion of Cattle Shed.
4. Completion Certificate from Area Assistant Director/Veterinary Officer.
5. Notarized agreement Bond in prescribed format.

## **DAIRY EQUIPMENT SCHEME (AMENDED) Modified**

### **Eligibility: -**

1. All the farmers having dairy Milch animals.
2. Farmer should be a bonafide resident of Goa for at least preceding 5 years, own a cattle shed with milch animals in the state of Goa.

### **Procedure:-**

The farmer should apply on a prescribed application form in duplicate as at Annexure-I and submit it through the local Veterinary Officer/Assistant Director along with

- a) 5 years residential certificate.
- b) Self Certified copy of ration card or Election card or any other proof of identity and address issued by Government of Goa, India including Nationalized Bank.
- c) Affidavit and Agreement signed & completed in all respects.
- d) 2 passport size photographs of the Applicant.
- e) Quotations of the items to be purchased.

Duly filled in consent form should be appended to the application for seeding of Aadhaar card details.

The concerned Officer shall scrutinize the application and forward it to the Directorate of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, Patto – Panaji within 30 days of its receipt.

On approval of application, which will have a validity of one year, the beneficiary shall submit the original purchase receipts or bills from authorized dealers/suppliers along with duly certified photographs within 90 days to the local Assistant Director/ Veterinary Officer, for onward submission to the Directorate.

On receiving the documents completed in all respects the Dept. will release the subsidy within 60 days maximum.

The concerned Officer shall maintain a register of all the equipment purchased under the scheme.

### **Conditions for release of subsidy: -**

1. Subsidy will be available for purchase of only new equipment/ implements as per Annexure-II for a Dairy Unit, provided the farmer has not claimed the subsidy for the items purchased earlier under any other scheme.
2. The beneficiary shall sign a Bond with the Department before the release of subsidy.
3. Subsidy @ 75% of the permissible cost of the equipment as per Annexure- II shall be limited to Rs. 2.0 lakhs only on the total equipments purchased.

4. Subsidy amount shall be directly credited to beneficiary's bank account through Electronic Clearance System (ECS) only.

5. Subsidy will be released only if the farmer has the approval of the Directorate in Advance for permission to purchase the equipment.

6. Claims for purchase of dairy equipment be entertained provided the total claims do not exceed Rs. 2.0 lakhs as subsidy per beneficiary.

7. However, Government may relax any of the clauses as felt deemed fit necessary from time to time.

8. Items mentioned at serial Nos. 1, 2, 3, 8, 9, 10, 13, 15, 16, 18, 22 and 23 in Annexure-II shall be purchased from authorized dealers registered with Directorate of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services, Govt. of Goa

9. Photographs of duly installed dairy equipment specially the Generator set, chaff cutter, shed washer, milking machine and of WALL MOUNTED/PEDESTAL INDUSTRIAL FAN with its respective serial number\* and with the beneficiary in the background should be forwarded to the Area Officer along with the bill. The area officer to verify the equipment vis a vis the photographs and the duly certified photographs with the bill should be forwarded to Head Office for release of subsidy.

\*The serial number of the machinery should essentially be either embossed on the equipment or alternatively be punched on a metal plate affixed to the motor. Also, the beneficiary should ensure that the warranty card is duly stamped by the dealer.

Interpretation:- If any question arises regarding interpretation of any clause, word, expression of the scheme, the decision shall lie with Government, which shall be final and binding on all concerned.

### **GOATERY SCHEME Assistance for Goat Rearing**

#### **Eligibility:**

1. Any farmer residing for minimum 5 years in the state.
2. Should have undergone training in Goat Management.
3. Should have goat shed on height of approx. 1.5 mts. from ground admeasuring minimum 30 sq mts. with flooring of bamboo/matti and roof of tiles/sheets/straw.

#### **DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED:**

- a) Residence Certificate (minimum 5 years residence).
- b) Aadhar consent form.
- c). Certificate of training in Goat Management.
- d) Documents indicating the ownership of land in Form No.I& XIV or copy of lease deed for 3 years or NOC from the Land Owner for 3 years in case of Tenants for the purpose of Goat farming.

e) Passport size photograph of the applicant.

f) On approval of Application, a Bond and Affidavit has to be submitted as per Annexure I & II of the Scheme.

**Pattern of Assistance:**

The Scheme comprises of 10 does and one buck (of which 5 pregnant and 5 empty) between the ages of 1-2 yrs. The maximum cost of each female goat for a maximum weight of 20 kgs will be Rs. 6000/- at Rs.300/- per kg live weight. Subsidy @ 75 % subsidy would be Rs. 4500/- Hence for 10 goats for a cost of maximum Rs. 60,000/- the maximum subsidy would be Rs 45,000/-. The maximum cost of one buck for a maximum weight of 25 kgs. will be Rs.7,500/- at Rs. 300/- per kg live weight and the maximum subsidy @ 75% would be Rs. 5625/-. The total cost of the goat unit (10+1) shall be limited to Rs.67,500/- (Rupees sixty-seven Thousand five Hundred Only). One time subsidy will be released at the rate of 75% that is Rs.50,625/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand six hundred twenty-five Only).

Incentives towards transportation of goats if purchased within the state shall be Rs.2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Only) or actual cost of transportation whichever is lower and if purchased from outside the state of Goa it shall be Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five Thousand Only) or actual cost of transportation whichever is lower.

The goat shed should be @ 1.5 sq. mts. area per goat. The shed should be at height of 1.5 mts. from the ground with cement poles and flooring ideally made from bamboo/ matti with roof of sheets/ tiles with wooden or netting partitions. The total area for approx 20 goats is 30 sq.mts.

The breakup of the shed cost is as under:

Shed Size: 3.5mts. width and 8 mts. breadth

Height raised to 1.5 mts. from the ground with cement poles (3 mts. 3 nos. poles @Rs. 500/- each and 2.5 mts. 8 nos. poles @ Rs.400/- per pole ----Total Rs. 4700/-)

Flooring of bamboo / Matti (approx. 40 nos. large bamboo @ Rs.150/- each---- Total Rs. 6000/-)

Roofing of asbestos sheets for more durability from rough weather. (1.5mt x1 mt. x 30 nos.@ Rs. 300/-per sheet---Total Rs. 9000/-)

Netting all around the shed with two internal partitions. (20 mts. all around@ Rs.350/- per mt.---Total Rs.7000/-)

8 mt GI pipe 3 nos. @ Rs. 1200/- each ---Total Rs.3600/-

The total shed cost shall be approx. Rs. 30,300/- subsidized @ 75% which would be Rs.22,725/-

## **Pashupalan Scheme**

### **Eligibility:**

- All farmers availing the Artificial Insemination Facility for cattle and buffalo and registered with the local Government Veterinary Services.
- N.G.Os, Goshalas, Community Farms and other organizations availing the A.I. to cows & buffaloes.
- All farmers irrespective of their financial status.
- All the farmers having cross-bred female calves/improved buffalo female calves/Indigenous breed calves namely Sahiwal, Gir & Red Sindhi, either born out of A.I. or calves born to existing cows and buffaloes or bought along with animals under Kamdhenu Scheme or Western Ghat Scheme or Modern Dairy Scheme/purchased locally under any other scheme of the Government.

### **Procedure :**

The scheme consists of three phases. The first phase deals with the Artificial Insemination of Non-descript cows and buffaloes. The second phase is the confirmation of pregnancy of inseminated animals and feeding incentives.

The third phase deals with rearing of female calves from birth to 27 months. All the Cross Bred calves, Improved buffalo calves and pure-bred calves of Indigenous breeds namely Sahiwal, Gir & Red Sindhi shall be included in the scheme.

#### **A. PHASE- 1**

1. The caste certificate if SC/ST/ Dhangar is required to be submitted by the beneficiary.
2. The beneficiary shall submit Xerox copy of bank saving account book indicating account number, MICR code, and IFSC code.
- 3 The beneficiary should register his entire local (non-descript) cattle & buffaloes with the local Veterinary Dispensary or Veterinary Hospital free of cost.
- 4 The beneficiary should intimate the local Veterinary Centre whenever the Non-descript cow/buffalo exhibits oestrus. On insemination the beneficiary is given an incentive of Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) per A.I. for 1<sup>st</sup> A.I. and Rs.200/- (Rupees Two Hundred only) for 2<sup>nd</sup> A.I., which will be directly deposited in his bank account on submission of records by the Veterinary Officer/Assistant Director of the area in form no. I, and on submission of advance receipt from the beneficiary.
- 5 The cow/buffalo has to be kept tied on the day of A.I. and two days subsequent to the heat, so as to avoid natural service by local bull.
- 6 The beneficiary is entitled to this benefit only for one A.I. per cycle.
- 7 No additional incentives will be given for repeat of A.I. for the same oestrous cycle.

#### **B. Phase 2 (Local Cows and Buffaloes)**

1. The Animals under the scheme will be microchipped in the third month after confirmation of pregnancy.
2. The local Veterinary Doctor will then recommend the case to Head Office for feed incentive in Form II
3. On confirmation of pregnancy, the Beneficiary is entitled for incentive from the 4<sup>th</sup> month onward on feed, fodder & miscellaneous expenditure amounting Rs.2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Only) per month, on submission of monthly progress report in Form III by area V.O/A.D.
4. To avail the benefits of the scheme the beneficiary should keep the animal tied and feed the animal.
5. Feed allowance will be discontinued in case of disposal of the animal, abortion / death of animal and non-stall feeding of animals & malnutrition of animals.

### C. Phase 3

1. On birth of a female cross-bred calf or improved buffalo female calf, to local cow or local buffalo, an amount of Rs. 4,000/- will be given as incentive to cover the beneficiary's initial financial expenditure on receipt of intimation of birth of female calf in Form No. IV from the beneficiary through the area officer.
2. The calf will be given feed allowance from birth to 27 months.
3. Cross-bred female calves/improved buffalo calves/Indigenous breed calves namely Sahiwal, Gir & Red Sindhi born, should be registered immediately on birth at the nearest Veterinary Dispensary / Hospital in Form no. V
4. Cross-bred female calves/improved buffalo calves/Indigenous breed calves namely Sahiwal, Gir & Red Sindhi below one month age bought along with animals under any Departmental Scheme/purchased locally should be registered & can be included in this scheme.
5. The feeding allowance is as follows – calf feeding allowance will be provided to all the calves that have attained the weight of at least 30 kgs at 3 months.
6. Calves under the scheme should gain at least 30 kg per quarter.
7. To avail the benefits of the scheme the beneficiary should keep the animal tied and feed the animal so as to gain a body weight of 30 kgs per quarter.
8. The beneficiary will be provided subsidy @ 75% of the estimated expenditure, thus motivating more farmers to rear the female calves under Pashupalan Scheme.
9. In case of S.C. / S.T. & Dhargar Community beneficiary 100% subsidy will be provided.
10. Here below is chart showing estimated expenditure and subsidy component: -

#### **GUIDELINES FOR RELEASE OF SUBSIDY: -**

1. Calf should attain the desired weight as prescribed in the scheme.
2. The Area Assistant Director/Veterinary Officer shall submit the quarterly weight gain certificate to the head office for approval as per Annexure “A” for each quarter.
3. Applicant should submit the Xerox copy of his /her bank saving account number from any nationalized or co-operative Bank.
4. Subsidy amount will be directly credited to the beneficiary’s account after receiving the quarterly weight gain certificate as per Annexure “A” for each quarter.

#### **TARGET GROUPS:**

The target groups under the scheme are the individual farmers, N.G.Os, Goshalas, Community Farms and other organizations owning Non descript cattle/buffalo and Cross Bred calves, Improved buffalo calves and pure bred calves of Indigenous breeds namely Sahiwal, Gir& Red Sindhi. There shall be no discrimination against any beneficiary since one of the objectives of the scheme is to stop the nuisance of “Stray Cattle,” this can be achieved only if all local animals are netted into the scheme irrespective of the financial background of the owner

#### **COMMUNITY DAIRY FARMING SCHEME (AMENDED 2019)**

##### **ELIGIBILITY**

1. Any group having minimum 5 members and registered with competent authority.
2. Should compulsorily possess irrigated land for Green Fodder Cultivation at the rate of minimum 5 acres for 50 animals besides the area for infrastructure development.
3. The scheme is applicable only for new unit.
4. Each member of the group shall be resident of Goa for at least preceding five years, with experience in dairy management.

**DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED:**

The full-fledged project report of the proposed unit along with the following required documents.

- i. Documents indicating the ownership of land in Form no. I & XIV/ Sale deed or copy of notarized lease deed or legitimized NOC from landlord.
- ii. NOC and construction license from prescribed authority.
- iii. Certificate of registration of the group from competent authority.
- iv. Letter from the Financing Institution having ECS system, willing to finance the beneficiary.
- v. Residence Certificate of each member issued by competent authority (preceding 05 years ).
- vi. Certified copy of Aadhar Card of each member.
- vii. Certificate of practical training in dairy management (of all the members)
- viii. Passport size photograph of each applicant
- ix. Survey site plan/plan of the cattle shed, Store room,
- x. Notarised authority from group members to the leader of the group.
- xi. Annexure showing the details of the group members.

**PROCEDURE FOR APPLICATION: -**

The Group interested in availing this Scheme will have to apply in a prescribed application form through Area Assistant Director/Veterinary Officer along with a non-refundable processing fee of Rs. 500/- (Rupees five hundred only)

**DETAIL GUIDELINES OF THE SCHEME:**

- 1) The scheme intends to promote Dairy farming as an Industry and to provide self-employment to the youth by assisting the interested community Groups, desirous in establishing a Dairy Farm, wherein the Group can buy Cross Bred Cows/Improved She Buffaloes/ Indigenous breed of cows namely Sahiwal, Gir and Red Sindhi.
- 2) The Group should be registered with competent authority.
- 3) The eligible applicant Group should complete the sanctioned project in all respects within six months of sanction.
- 4) Purchase of Milch animals shall be allowed only after completion of the infrastructure of the proposed farm in all respect.
- 5) Fodder cultivation is mandatory and should be undertaken at least two months prior to purchase of animals.
- 6) Milch animals under the Scheme have to be necessarily purchased from Cattle Mela held at Govt. Livestock Farms or from outside the state. Transit insurance is mandatory in case the animals are purchased from outside the state.

7) Unit cost of Cross Bred Cow/Improved She Buffalo/ Indigenous breed cows namely Sahiwal, Gir and Red Sindhi shall be limited to Rs. 70,000/- per animal expected to yield 2700 litres of milk per lactation for the purpose of release of subsidy.

8) Identification of all the animals under the scheme must be done only through Microchips system.

9) The animals purchased under the scheme should be insured for a minimum period of 42 months.

10) After completion of the unit Area, Veterinary Officer/ Asst. Director shall submit relevant documents as required under the scheme to the Directorate of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, through the Financing Institution.

11) Agreement bond sworn before Notary/Magistrate on stamp paper as per rule in force, in prescribed format has to be submitted for release of subsidy.

12) The area Veterinary Officer/ Asst. Director shall inspect and submit the report of the infrastructural work and fodder cultivation. If satisfied, may recommend purchase of milch animals sanctioned under the scheme.

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS** The subsidy will be released only after completion of unit in all respects. The following documents are required for release of subsidy.

1. Bills/Voucher pertaining to construction of cattle shed, cow dung pit, store room, along with the valuation certificate from authorized valuer, duly certified by area Veterinary Officer/Assistant Director.

2. Cash receipts in original from authorized dealer of the equipment's & machinery.

3. Purchase receipts of milch animals along with transport receipts, health certificate, purchase statement duly certified by area Veterinary Officer/Assistant Director.

4. Document showing insurance of milch animals for 42 months from authorized insurance company

5. One time subsidy will be released after the completion of the unit in all respect and only after inspection by the Departmental Committee. The subsidy amount shall be credited by ECS mode to the account of the beneficiary Group.

The beneficiary Community group should run the unit for a minimum period of 10 years. An agreement in this regard is to be signed by the beneficiary Community Group with the Directorate of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, Panaji, Goa.

## **PIGGERY DEVELOPMENT For 20 Sows and Two Boars**

### **Eligibility:**

Any farmer residing for minimum 15 years in the state.

### **Pattern of Assistance:**

The approved unit cost for the Piggery unit is Rs.1,97,500/- of which Rs.49,375/- (Rupees Forty-Nine Thousand three Hundred and Seventy five only) shall be the subsidy component. The maximum subsidy admissible is 25% of the unit cost

### **Procedure:**

1. Beneficiary should submit the application for setting up of piggery unit for 20 Sows and 2 boars to the Directorate of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, Panaji in the prescribed form through the respective Veterinary Officer/ Assistant Director of his jurisdiction.
2. N.O.C. from the respective Village Panchayat for setting up the Piggery unit should be enclosed along with application form.
3. The Beneficiary can set up the Piggery unit with his own finance or by taking loan from any financing Institutions of his/her choice. In case of loan from the Bank, the subsidy should be disbursed directly to the loanees account.
4. The beneficiary can purchase the pigglings from the Government Piggery Farm, Curti Ponda Goa. In case the pigglings are not available in the Govt. piggery farm, he can purchase the required number of pigglings from any other private Farm in consultation with the respective Veterinary Officer / Assistant Director.
5. The beneficiary should set up the unit within 3 months from the date of sanction, of the application
6. Only on receipt of utilization certificate and all other required receipts etc form the respective Veterinary Officer / Assistant Director the subsidy will be released to the beneficiary. In case he has availed Bank finance for setting up of the unit, the subsidy will be released to the Bank to be credited to the Beneficiary's loan account.
7. Before release of the subsidy the beneficiary has to execute the Bond stating that the unit will not be closed for a minimum period of 3 years from the date of release of subsidy.
8. The beneficiary should vaccinate the pigs regularly against Swine fever Disease, on the direction of the local Assistant Director/Veterinary Office.
9. The insurance of the pigs is optional and the beneficiary can insure the pigs, if he/she so desires, at his /her own cost.

**Documents are required for release of subsidy.**

(a) Bills / vouchers pertaining to the construction of Shed/ godown, Biogas plant (dung pit) if any etc duly certified by an approved valuer/Engineer.

(b) Purchase receipt of sows / boar piggings with health certificate from the area Veterinary Officer / Assistant Director. Cash receipt of equipment's purchased (Subsidy will be admissible for new equipments only) also duly certified by local Veterinary Officer/Assistant Director.

(c) The beneficiary should rear the unit for a minimum period of 6 years. An agreement is to be signed on a prescribed stamp paper by the beneficiary with the Department / Government.

(d) The beneficiary can start the unit by obtaining the loan from financial institutions. In this case subsidy will be released through the concerned financing institutions to be credited to the beneficiary's loan account.

(e) Certified copy of Aadhaar Card

**Financial Assistance for establishment of Modern Poultry Farm and purchase of Poultry Farm equipments****Eligibility:**

Any individual having some experience in Poultry Keeping.

**Pattern of Assistance:**

25% of cost of Plant and Machinery will be granted as subsidy subject to maximum of Rs.2.00 lakhs to any individual for setting up Poultry Units. The minimum unit size should be 2000 broilers (500 broilers per fortnight) or 5000 layers.

**Procedure:**

1. The beneficiary can start a Unit with his own finance or by availing loan from the Financial Institution. In case the beneficiary avails loan from Financial Institution subsidy will be released through the concerned Financial Institution.

Plant and Machinery includes:

1. Poultry shed
2. Cages in case of cage system
3. Store room
4. First batch of day-old chicks/layers
5. Water pump and water tank
6. Feather plucker
7. Feeders and waterers
8. Electric fittings.

**Conditions:**

- I. The unit should be located in Goa.
- II. The subsidy will be released only after completion of the 1st batch of Poultry Birds.
- III. Subsidy is admissible only for new equipments/machinery.

The beneficiary should run the unit for a minimum period of 10 years and an Agreement in this regard is to be signed by the beneficiary with the Department.

**Procedure:**

The Project Report of the proposed Unit is to be submitted to the Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services through the Area Veterinary Officer/Assistant Director along with the following documents.

a) Documents indicating ownership of land in Form I & XIV or copy of Lease Deed or N.O.C. from the Landlord in case of Tenants.

b) In case of lease the same should be for a minimum period of 10 years from the date of starting the Unit.

c) In case of Tenants NOC from the Landlord to run the unit for a minimum period of 10 years should be obtained from Panchayat/Municipality.

d) The concerned Officer after inspecting the site will submit the application to the Directorate with his observations.

e) The Project Report/papers will be scrutinized and approval of the project will be sent to the applicant.

f) After completion of the Unit, the following documents are required to be submitted by the applicant for release of subsidy.

- Bill, Vouchers pertaining to constructions.
- Purchase receipt of equipments, machinery and 1st batch of poultry birds.
- Valuation certificate of shed and stores from approved valuer.
- The Veterinary Officer/Assistant Director will submit all these documents along with completion certificate to the Director of Animal Husbandry.
- The Dy. Director will inspect the Unit and submit his observations for sanctioning the subsidy by the Department.

Maximum Unit Cost admissible for subsidy.

### **Scheme for Breeding of Local Cows in the State of Goa**

#### **Eligibility**

- All farmers availing of the Artificial Insemination Facility for Local cattle and registered with the local Government Veterinary Services.
- N.G.O's and other organizations availing of the A.I. to local cows will also be eligible for the benefits under the scheme.
- All farmers irrespective of their financial status.
- There is no limitation to the number of animals covered by individual farmer, or organization.

#### **Procedure**

The scheme consists of two phases. The first phase deals with the Artificial Insemination of the Local Cows. The second phase is the confirmation of pregnancy and feeding incentive. Both phases are to be implemented simultaneously and automatically thus reducing the need for paperwork.

A. Phase 1

- No documents are required to be submitted by the farmer.
- The farmer should register all his local Cattle with the local Veterinary Dispensary or Veterinary Hospital free of cost.
- The farmer should intimate the local Veterinary Centre whenever the animal shows heat symptoms. The farmer is then entitled to a cash incentive of Rupees One Hundred per A.I. of local Cow after performing the A.I. of his Cow, which is on proper heat.
- The Cow has to be kept tied on the day of A.I. and two days subsequent to the Heat, so as to, avoid natural service by local bull.
- No Additional cash will be given for repeat of A.I. for the same heat. Incentive will be given only for one repeat A.I. Cycle @ Rs.100/- (Rupees One Hundred only) per A.I.

B. Phase 2

- The Animals under the scheme will be micro chipped in the third month after confirmation of pregnancy.
- The local Veterinary Doctor will then recommend the case to Head Office for feed incentive.
- On confirmation of pregnancy, the Farmer is entitled for feed incentive from the 4th month onward @ 2.5 Kg per day per animal for six months.
- All local Veterinary Doctors may be given a reserve fund of upto Rs 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) (for cash payment to farmers per local A.I., which will be monitored by Assistant Director, KVSc, under the supervision of the Deputy Director (Gyn).
- Feed allowance will be discontinued in case of abortion / death of animal.
- The Local Officer may report regarding non-stall feeding of the animals, in which case the feed allowance may be reconsidered.

**TARGET GROUPS:**

The farmers owning local cattle are mainly from the rural sector. However local animals in the urban areas will also be considered, and could be given priority so that the menace of stray cattle in urban areas could be eliminated. Local animals reared by N.G.O's or other organizations will also be considered for benefits. There shall be no discrimination against any farmer since one of the objective of the scheme is to stop the nuisance of stray cattle by improving the germplasm, this can be achieved only if all local animals are netted into the scheme irrespective of the financial background of the owner.

### **Incentives for Silage Production**

Incentives for silage making will be given @ Rs. 2/per kg of silage production (i.e. cost of silo bag/pit and labour charges per kg silage production) The incentives will be given quarterly for silage produced for three years (Twelve quarters). Minimum silage production per quarter is 500 kg.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

1. Any individual/ farmer/ agricultural labourer/ Dairy Society / Farmers club/ Self Help Group can take up the scheme. In case of Hydroponic Fodder production and Silage making, beneficiary must have minimum 5 Milch animals and minimum 5 years residence in State of Goa.
2. Dairy Society/ Farmers Club/ Self help Group who are interested in Green Fodder cultivation in the available land within Goa are eligible
3. The beneficiary should after receipt of initial approval letter from the Director, Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, prepare the land and in case of Hydroponic /silage making unit, set up the unit, complete the cultivation/ production in the proposed land within 2 months period, which should be confirmed and supervised by the concerned Area Officer/ Extension Officer.
4. Any individual Farmer/ Dairy Co-operative Society/ self help group/ farmers club, Bachat Ghat are eligible, provided they arrange the land, which may be even any fallow land, Agricultural land and Marad Land etc. by providing the required Form I & XIV and Affidavit in prescribed format.
5. The beneficiaries who have cultivated Green fodder under existing Departmental Scheme are eligible to apply under this Scheme.

#### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE SCHEME**

2. The applicant should show his proposed land area to the respective concerned Officer who will visit and confirm availability and usefulness of the land for processing the application further.

3. In case of Perennial and seasonal Green fodder cultivation, the minimum area of the land to be cultivated is Rs. 500 sq. mt

4. The beneficiary may provide Form I & XIV , notarized NOC from Landlord in case of tenant or Notarized Affidavit in prescribed format

5. In case of fodder plot cultivated by Dairy societies, Self help groups, Farmers Club, the distribution or sale of the fodder produced by the member is their own responsibility.

The Scheme does not permit rearing of these L.I.T birds along with broilers and layers on one common premises. h) The beneficiary availing birds under Establishment of Backyard Poultry Unit (Special component Plan Scheme for SC & ST) are not entitled for this Scheme.

i) The beneficiary cannot Practice Trading activities and farming under one common premises where in L.I.T. birds of the scheme are reared.

j) The scheme will not be applicable to (a)Poultry Birds Traders, (b) Egg Traders (c) Poultry Hatcheries, (d) Integrated Farmers & (e) Contract Farmers.

k) The beneficiary should make his own arrangements to market the produce.

Midyear shifting from Kerosene to Petrol is permitted on pro rata basis and once shifted cannot claim Kerosene subsidy again in future. i.e. route of claim to petrol is one way route only. Beneficiary will be entitled to avail the same Every YEAR.

## **GENERAL INSURANCE SCHEME FOR ACTIVE FISHERMEN**

The insurance premium of Rs.200/- shall be paid by the Government and by the Life Insurance Company on 50:50 basis.

Under this scheme, the nominee of the deceased Fishermen will receive benefits in the event of death by accident or partial/total permanent disability are as under:-

- On death due to accident Rs. 75,000/- for the nominee.
- Permanent/total disability due to accident Rs. 50,000/-

- Partial disability due to accident Rs.37,500/-

Besides the above, in the event of natural death of member a sum of Rs. 30,000/- will become payable to the nominee.

**Interest Subsidy Scheme on loans for Agriculture and Allied activities**

Under this scheme loans upto Rs. 5.00 lakhs and below are recommended at 4% interest. be eligible for interest subsidy.

**Institution eligible for interest subsidy:**

Nationalized Banks, Scheduled Commercial Banks, Goa State Cooperative Bank and Primary Agricultural Cooperatives (PAC's).

**Rate of Interest and Subsidy:**

Rate of interest applicable to the fishermen is 4% and the interest over and above the ceiling charged by the institutions is borne to the Government as interest subsidy to the farmer and is directly released to the institution. The interest subsidy is extended only to the agricultural loans where payment of instalments of Principal and Interest as specified by the lending bank is regular.

Under this scheme Loans for purchase of canoe, outboard motors, fishing nets, fish finders and Global Positioning Systems (GPS) for fishing vessels, construction for fish hold in vessels, setting up of aquaculture farms, mussel farming, aquarium fish farming, drying and processing units, ice plants for fisheries and repairs and modification of fishing vessels is given. Short, medium and long time loans are eligible for interest subsidy for a maximum period of five years. In case of long term loans beyond five years interest subsidy is granted only for a period of five years.

Release of Subsidy: Interest subsidy is released on quarterly basis, for this purposes, every bank branch, send their claim to the Directorate of Fisheries as the case may be in the following tabular format, enclosed as Annexure duly consolidated for each bank branch, with office seal of the bank within one month after each quarter ending June, September, December and March.

**DIRECTORATE OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (DW&CD) PANAJI- GOA**

**LAADLI LAXMI SCHEME:**

**Eligibility and Other Conditions: -**

1) Any Girl who fulfils all of the following conditions is eligible to apply:

- (a) born in the State of Goa;
  - (b) resident of Goa for the last fifteen years; and
  - (c) (i) whose at least one of the parents is born in Goa and is also a resident of Goa for the last fifteen years;
- or

(ii) whose one of the parents is residing in Goa for last twenty-five years. Provided that a Girl, who is born outside Goa, shall be eligible if she is:

- (a) resident of Goa for the last fifteen years;
- (b) educated in Goa; and
- (c) (i) whose at least one of the parents is born in Goa and is also a resident of Goa for the last fifteen years; or
- (d) (ii) whose one of the parents is residing in Goa for last twenty-five years.

Financial Assistance: - The beneficiaries under this scheme are paid Rs. 1.00 lakh as financial assistance provided they fulfil the criteria therein in the below mentioned category as under:-

- i) on attaining the age of 18 years
  - ii) or on the occasion of her marriage and is applicable to girls between 19 to 40 years of age upto 31/03/2016 and now extended to 45 years prospectively w.e.f. 1/04/2016
- The beneficiaries on attaining the age of 18 years are paid Rs. 1.00 lakh as financial assistance by means of bank fixed deposit jointly in the name of the Director of Women and Child Development and the applicant (the Girl). The beneficiaries on the occasion of marriage are paid cash through the Bank. The beneficiary who is in possession of the Fixed deposit under the Scheme is now allowed to withdraw the amount after attaining the age of 21 years for her use in business/profession or for her further studies. Application Procedure: - The eligible beneficiary shall apply to the Director of Women and Child Development, Panaji-Goa in the prescribed form, complete in all respects with the self-certified copies of the following documents; (1) Self Certified copy of Birth Certificate of the applicant.

(2) Residence Certificate of the applicant. In lieu of the Residence Certificate, the previous School Leaving Certificate and the current Bonafide Student Certificate issued by the recognized Educational Institution in which the girl is presently studying can also be produced. However, in case of girls who discontinued education at school level, the gap period from the time of discontinuation of education till completion of 18 years of age/marriage as the case may be proved by production of residence certificate. In case of graduates, the certificates of passing of Xth, XIIth and graduation is adequate evidence.

(3) Self Certified copy of Aadhar Card.

(4) Self Certified Copy of the Civil Marriage Registration Certificate which may also include the first registration certificate.

(5) Self Certified copy of 15 years or 25 years Residence Certificate of one of the parent (s) of the applicant as the case may be. In lieu of the Residence Certificate, any documentary evidence to prove the residence for the specified period can also be produced which may include: (i) The land records i.e. tenancy rights; mundcarial rights; occupancy rights, etc. (ii) Employment certificate; or (iii) Any such records to the satisfaction of the Committee.

(6) Self Certified copy of Birth certificate of one of the parent(s) of the applicant as the case may be. If no birth certificate is available, one of the following documents can be produced showing the details namely the date and place of Birth of the parent(s): (i) Baptism certificate; (ii) School leaving certificate of the parent(s). (iii) Any document which establishes that one of the grandparents of the girl have lived in Goa around the time of the date of birth claimed by the parent(s). (iv) Any such records, which establishes the date of birth of the parent(s).

(7) Self-Declaration.

(8) Pre-receipt with revenue stamp (in duplicate) as prescribed. The Laadli Laxmi Scheme is being implemented through the branches of the following Banks. 1. State Bank of India 2. Bank of India 3. H.D.F.C. Bank

## **GRIHA AADHAR SCHEME**

### **Eligibility and other conditions**

Any married woman above the age of 18 years, who fulfils all of the following conditions, is eligible to apply:

(i) She should be a resident of Goa for the last fifteen years; and

(ii) The gross income of the husband and wife, taken together should not exceed Rs.3,00,000/- per annum.

Note 1: The term „married woman“ includes a widow and a divorcee. In such cases the gross income of the beneficiary should not exceed`1, 50,000/- per annum.

Note 2: The term „gross income“, means the income receivable by the beneficiary as salary, any sort of remuneration, any sort of earnings from profession, agriculture or business or any other income from any other sources; before computing any other amount accounted towards statutory, essential and other deductions required to be done from the gross income. Provided, that the beneficiary or the husband should not be in receipt of the benefit under the Dayanand Social Security Scheme (DSSS) of the Directorate of Social Welfare, Government of Goa. However, a widow having a child living shall be eligible for benefit under this scheme, even though she is a beneficiary of the DSSS till the child attains 18 years of age. Financial Assistance: - The beneficiary under the scheme shall be paid an amount of Rs. 1,200/- per month, as financial assistance. Application procedure: - The eligible beneficiary shall apply to the Director of Women and Child Development, Panaji - Goa in the prescribed form (Annexure - A), complete in all respects with the self-certified copies of the following documents:

(i) Aadhar Card,

(ii) Marriage Certificate.

(iii) Proof of present residential address (which may include a ration card; Election Photo Identity Card (EPIC), or any such document which establishes the present address);

(iv) 15 years Residence Certificate.

- (v) Income Certificate issued by the Competent Authority, which may also include Salary Certificate / Income Certificate.
- (vi) Attested copy of savings bank account pass book (with IFSC and MICR details); and
- (vii) Birth certificate of the child along with life certificate (in case of widow who is DSSS beneficiary)

(a) The applications shall be scrutinized and sanction will be issued by the Director of Women and Child Development the Director of Women and Child Development shall establish facilitation centers in the taluka level offices for processing the application forms. A maximum number of upto 15000 applications shall be sanctioned in a calendar month.

(b) The financial assistance of Rs.1200/- (Rupees one thousand two hundred only) shall be paid every month directly into the savings bank account of the eligible beneficiary by ECS facility subject to other conditions.

#### **THE INTERNSHIP SCHEME FOR STUDENTS OF COUNSELLING/ PSYCHOLOGY/ SOCIAL WORK/HOME SCIENCE ETC:**

##### **Eligibility:**

(i) Any student who have passed out from any of the recognised university with a Master Degree in social Service/Social Work/Sociology/Psychology/Home Science/Post Graduate Diploma in Counselling etc.,

(ii) Shall be a Student who has passed out as post graduate within three year prior to applying for the internship.

(iii) Should have obtained atleast 50%marks in aggregate in the final year.

##### **Financial Assistance:**

a) The student interns shall be paid Rs. 15,000/- lump Sum as internship allowance per month and for part of the month shall be paid on pro rata basis and there shall be no other compensation paid to the interns. The period of internship shall be for maximum of twelve month.

b) The interns shall be required to give a Bond for a value of one month allowance (Rs.15,000/-) for ensuring proper completion of the internship period without any break and incase the intern leaves in between then the intern shall give a notice of at least 30 days and shall be liable to pay the bond.

c) The value of Rs.15,000/- to the Government or else the equivalent amount if any due to the intern from the monthly allowance shall be forfeited.

##### **Application procedure:**

a) The applications received shall be scrutinized and accepted by the Department and all eligible candidates shall be called for an interview.

b) A Departmental Selection Committee for the selection of candidates shall comprise of the following :- a) Director, Women & Child Development as Chairperson b) Deputy Director, Admn, of

DWCD, Member. b) Chairperson CWC (North), Member c) Member of Juvenile Justice Board (North), Member. c) The selected intern students will have to undergo training and work at the following places:-i) State run children Home, ii) Protective Home for Women, iii) Juvenile Justice Boards, iv) Child Welfare Committees, v) At any other Children"s Home, Shelter Homes etc recognized by the Government.

d) They shall work as per directions and under total supervision of the officers incharge at the respective place of deployment during the period of internship or when deployed for field work at any place for preparation of Probation Officers report or for Home study report inquiry etc.

#### **GOA VILLAGE & MUNICIPAL CHILD COMMITTEE GRANTS AND AWARDS SCHEME 2014 (GVMCCGS):**

##### **Eligibility:**

a) The applicant shall be the concerned local body i.e. a Panchayat or a Municipal local body should, in order to qualify for the grant, must have established a Village or Municipal Child Committee (hereinafter referred to as the Committee) as prescribed under Rule 7 of The Goa Children's Homes Rules, 2004.

b) The Committee must have met at least once in the last three months prior to submission of the application for grants to discuss and resolve the issues relating to children within the jurisdiction of the local body.

c) The local body who has promoted the Committee should provide the space for facilitating sittings of the Committee in its premises as and when required. **Financial Assistance:** The local body who have set up the Child Committee under Rule 7 and such committee has been functioning and carrying on its work satisfactorily shall be eligible for an annual financial grant of Rs 10,000/- towards administrative expenses incurred on organizing the activities of the Committee. The grant will be released in single instalment within three months. The Director, Women & Child Development shall be the competent Sanctioning Authority for these grants. All payments will be made only through electronic transfers favouring the local body concerned. Application procedure: Application for financial grant shall be addressed to the Director, Women and Child Development and submitted by:-

a) The Village Panchayat fulfilling the eligibility conditions signed by its Secretary, along with the resolution of the Panchayat Body & proposal duly recommended by the concerned Block Development Officer.

b) In case of Municipality the proposal be signed by its Chief Executive, along with resolution of the body and submitted directly to the Director, Women & Child Development.

c) The applications for grant shall be submitted within six months from the commencement of the financial year. Except initially from the beginning of this scheme it shall be six months from the date of commencement of this scheme.

## **FOSTER CARE SCHEME(VATSALAYA)**

### **Eligibility:**

Criteria for selection of children to be assisted under the Scheme: Children in need of care and protection as defined in Section 2(d) of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2000, in the age group 0-18 years (may be extended to 21 years, subject to the assessment of Child Welfare Committee ([CWC]) shall be eligible under this Scheme and shall include:

- children affected by family breakdown or marital discord.
- children faced with upheavals caused by family illness, substance abuse or any other “crisis”. the children’s safety being “at risk”.
- natural or man-made disasters.
- orphaned, surrendered/relinquished, abandoned children.
- children who cannot be placed in adoption for various reasons.
- children in institutions who can be “reinstated” or “restored” back into families.
- a child in conflict with law.
- Eligibility criteria for selection of Foster parents

As far as possible the foster family should belong to a similar social-economic and cultural milieu. There shall be no discrimination in selection of foster-parents on the basis of caste, religion, ethnic status, disability or health status and the best interests of the child shall be paramount in deciding foster-care placement. The criteria for selection shall be in accordance with Section 35 of the Model Rules of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act:

- (i) Foster parents should have stable emotional adjustment within the family;
- (ii) Foster parents should have an income in which they are able to meet the basic needs of the child. The foster care maintenance allowance/assistance should not be their motivation for caring for the child and they should not be totally dependent on the same;
- (iii) The CWC shall assess whether the monthly family income is adequate to take care of foster children;
- (iv) Medical reports of all the members of the family residing in the premises should be obtained including checks on Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV), Tuberculosis (TB) and Hepatitis B to determine their medical fitness;
- (v) The foster parents, should have, adequate exposure, orientation and capacity in child caring and the capacity to provide good child care the foster parents should be physically, mentally and emotionally stable;
- (vi) The home should have adequate space and basic facilities;
- (vii) The foster care family should be willing to follow rules laid down including making regular visits to a paediatrician, immunization of the child, maintenance of child’s health records;
- (viii) The family should be willing to sign an agreement and to return the child to the Child Welfare Committee if directed by the Committee to do so.

- (ix) The foster parents should be willing to attend training or orientation programmes on child care and health, etc;
- (x) The foster parents should motivate the child to study and be willing to send the child to regular school or for vocational training.

Financial Assistance: On the basis of the assessment of the Child Care Coordinator, monthly Foster Care allowance payable to the foster families for the welfare of the child will be Rs.2,500/-per month. Provided that the children who are Beneficiaries of the Dayanand Social Security Scheme (DSSS) of the Directorate of Social Welfare, Government of Goa, shall not be Eligible for Foster Care allowances under this scheme. On the basis of the assessment of the Child Care Coordinator, the maximum maintenance allowance per child or monthly Foster Care Allowance payable to the foster families will be as follows:-

Age Group	Amount
0 to 6 years	Rs. 1,500/- p.m.
6 to 14 years	Rs. 2,000/- p.m.
14 to 18 years	Rs. 2,500/- p.m.

**GOA (TECHNICAL /VOCATIONAL TRAINING TO SEX WORKERS AND SEXUALLY ABUSED WOMEN) SCHEME, 2013 (PRABHAT): -**

**Eligibility:**

- i) Women and Children who are victims of Commercial Sexual Exploitation.
- ii) The victim needs to either reside in Goa or be a native of Goa.
- iii) The place of commercial sexual exploitation is not a criterion for the eligibility (women and girls from Goa being commercially sexually exploited outside Goa also qualify).
- iv) For availing the benefit under this scheme the victim has to reside in Goa.

**Financial Assistance:**

- i) A victim of commercial sexual exploitation (excluding victims housed in Protective Home) will be provided a stipend of Rs. 2500/- per month, after rescue or exit from commercial sexual exploitation. The stipend will be paid for a period of three months or till she joins a livelihood programme, whichever is earlier.
- ii) A victim of commercial sexual exploitation, if she is interested in pursuing her education then she will be supported for her education till Standard XII. All the expenses related to her education, boarding, travel, fees, books, toiletries, etc., may be paid through the corpus fund created under clause 17 of the scheme subject to their commendations of the Monitoring Committee.
- iii) The victim shall be provided counselling by Probation Officer or by a person appointed as "Mentor" or by a professional counsellor or psychiatrist working in a Government or non-

Government Organization. Expenses incurred for fees, travel, medicine, etc., will be met through the corpus fund created under clause 17 of the scheme.

- iv) The victim shall be provided health services for all kinds of ailments at the Government hospital. Victims suffering with HIV or Tuberculosis will be connected to ART and DOTS schemes. In cases where the victim is suffering from AIDS and requires Institutional care, she shall be admitted to one of the care centres meant for people with HIV/AIDS, for a period of six months.
- v) The children of the trafficked victim shall be provided counselling and assistance for admission in the school by the Probation Officer or by a person appointed as "Mentor". All the expenses related to the education of the children, such as boarding, travel, fees, books, toiletries, etc., upto Std. XII shall be met through the corpus fund created under clause 17 of the scheme.

### **FINANCIAL INCENTIVES TO MOTHERS WHO DELIVER A GIRL CHILD (MAMTA):**

#### **Eligibility and other Condition:**

- a) All mothers who deliver a live girl Child (maximum 02 deliveries) in the registered medical institution.
- b) The Scheme is available to all irrespective of their social / economical status.
- c) The mother should be resident of Goa for at least three years or married to a resident of Goa (document to that effect to be submitted).
- d) The eligible mother who delivers a girl child shall apply to the Child Development Project Officer through the local Anganwadi Centre along with a copy of the Birth report/Birth Certificate in the prescribed form within 45 days of the delivery of the girl Child. The benefits are directly credited to the declared Bank Account.

#### **Benefits:**

I. The beneficiaries (mother) under the Scheme shall be paid Rs. 10000/- as one time financial incentive through Electronic Clearing System (ECS)/ National Electronic Funds Transfer (NEFT) /Aadhaar Payment Bridge System (APBS)/ Automated Clearing House (ACH) at birth of a live Girl Child. (Apply within 45 days).

II. Those beneficiaries who were paid the 1st Instalment of Rs. 5000/- under the existing scheme shall be eligible for only balance amount (2nd instalment) of Rs. 5000/- (to apply within 45 days from the date of the Amended Scheme published in the official Gazette).

III. Those beneficiaries who had applied for 1st Instalment of Rs. 5000/- as on the date of this Amended Scheme published in the Official Gazette shall be eligible for Rs. 10,000/- as per the amended scheme.

IV. Those beneficiaries who were paid both 1st and 2nd Instalments shall not be eligible for any further incentives/benefit under the amended scheme and case shall be treated as closed.

Application procedure: The eligible mothers who deliver a girl child shall apply to the Child

Development Project Officer through the Anganwadi Worker along with a copy of the Birth report/Birth Certificate and relevant documents in the prescribed form, attached to the Scheme within 45 days of the delivery of the girl Child.

**GRANT-IN-AID SCHEME TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE MAHILA MANDALS/WOMEN'S SELF HELP GROUPS (SWAWLAMBHAN) :**

**Eligibility:**

Each Mahila Mandal shall fulfill following conditions to avail the scheme of grant in aid and financial assistance has valid registration with the competent Authority.

- 1) The Mahila Mandal should have valid registration with the Competent Authority.
- 2) [The compulsion of 2 years registration is deleted]
- 3) Each group shall submit the project report specifying the activities / training and list of prospective beneficiaries with educational details.
- 4) There shall be minimum 20 members for training / orientation. Financial Assistance:(i) Under the Scheme an amount of Rs. 20000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) shall be sanctioned as annual grants to the registered Mahila Mandal/ Women"s Self Help Group for successful functioning in the Goa State.

**Financial assistance**

Financial assistance of Rs. 5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) shall be sanctioned to the registered Mahila Mandals/Women"s Self Help Groups having atleast 20 members for undertaking any gainful self employment activity training orientation in the activities given in Annexure - III.

**Pattern of assistance. :-**

Each Mahila Mandal shall be disbursed following grants:

- (1) Rs. 20000/- as annual Grant-in-Aid for registered Mahila Mandal/Women"s Self Help Group for successful functioning in the Goa State.
- (2) Rs. 5000/- shall be sanctioned per course for purchase of raw materials to every Mahila Mandal for conducting any activity for self employment.
- (3) Resource persons/ Master Trainers/Instructors may be provided by the Directorate for each course of activity through CDPO"s.
- (4) An amount of Rs. 5000/- will be paid per course as fixed honorarium to the Master trainer/ instructor.
- (5) Actual TA incurred by the Master Trainers/Instructors shall be paid if travelling in the Taluka outside his/her jurisdiction. Application Procedure. Application for Financial assistance shall be submitted through the CDPO of the concerned block, Mukhya Sevika at the village level of the respective block in the prescribed format in Annexure-I and with the following documents.
  - 1) Copy of registration Certificate.
  - 2) Last two years Statement of Accounts.

- 3) Project report.
- 4) Detail list of beneficiaries

**Terms and Condition:**

- i) The amount sanctioned under the scheme shall be utilized for the purpose only and utilization certificates shall be submitted to the CDPO for countersignature & CDPO shall submit the same to the Director.
- ii) The grant of financial assistance under the scheme cannot be claimed as a matter of rights.
- iii) Financial Assistance shall be sanctioned on first come first served basis and subject to the Government decision.
- iv) Each Mahila Mandal/Self Help Group can identify and opt only one training programme at a time.
- v) The training duration shall not be less than 4 hours in a day for a training course of 5 days to 15 days.
- vi) Date, place and timing of the training programme shall be fixed by Mahila Mandal before commencement of the training and same shall be informed to the Directorate of Women & Child Development.
- vii) No additional liability of House Rent, Electricity Bill, Water Bill shall be borne by the Government under the scheme.
- viii) Regular attendance of the participants shall be maintained by the Mahila Mandal/Self Help Group.
- ix) Utilization certificate shall be submitted by Mahila Mandal/Self Help Group within a week after completion of the training programme failing which Grant-in-Aid for the next course shall not be sanctioned.
- x) Proper recording of the bills / voucher shall be maintained by the Mahila Mandal/Self Help Group and submitted to the CDPO through Mukhya Sevika for utilization

**RETIREMENT BENEFIT SCHEME FOR ANGANWADI WORKERS / ANGANWADI HELPERS:**

**Financial assistance: -**

- a) The AWWs & AWHs who have attained the age of 60 years shall be paid an amount of ₹3.00 Lakhs (Three Lakhs Only) and ₹1,50,000/- (One Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only) respectively under this Scheme.
- b) In case any member resigns before the date of retirement, but completes 10 years gets such member shall not ₹1,50,000 and ₹75,000 respectively on Medical grounds only.
- c) To become eligible for Retirement Benefit under the Scheme AWW/AWH should have completed minimum 20 years of Services as honorary worker in the ICDS. Other conditions: -
  - a) From the monthly honoraria payable to each AWW & AWH covered under Scheme to be invested either in Postal Recurring Deposit or any other way as may be approved by Director so as to derive additional benefits to payable to members on their retirement.

b) In case any of the members does not receive honoraria on account of absenteeism from duties or for any other reason during a particular month, the contribution shall be recovered from the honoraria payable for subsequent month.

c) In case of exit of any member from the service under ICDS before the age of 60 years due to resignation etc; the above contribution accumulated will be paid to her with interest applicable from time to time. In case of death of a member in service, such accumulated amount will be paid to her nominee.

### **SHELTER HOME FOR WOMEN (SHW)**

**Financial assistance:** The shelter Homes are given grants consisting of salary component and maintenance expenditure. **Eligibility:** Meant for Non-Government Voluntary Organization, registered under the registration of Societies Act, 1860, a public Trust registered under any law for the time being in force, local bodies, Govt. bodies or other bodies as specified by the Govt. having Managing Body with powers, duties and responsibilities, experience of working in the field of women and children welfare, and rendering their services without distinction of caste, religion or language

### **SCHEME FOR WELFARE OF CHILDREN IN NEED OF CARE AND PROTECTION.**

#### **Eligibility:**

1. Children who do not have either of the parents or near relatives;
2. Children of single parent families deprived of adequate family care due to death, desertion, prolonged illness, imprisonment of one of the parents and where the income of the family is less than Rs.500/- per month. Organizations that look after Destitute and orphaned children i.e.

#### **Financial assistance**

Grants are given to the registered Voluntary Organizations who are admitting destitute and orphaned children up to the age of 18 years. An amount of Rs.400/- per child per month is given to the organization if they house the children in their own premises and Rs.500/- per child per month if housed in rented premises.

### **BETI BACHAO BETI PADHAO (BBBP):**

#### **Financial Assistance:**

The BBBP scheme is a central sector scheme with 100% financial assistance to the State Government/UTs. The Ministry of Women & Child Development will transfer the funds to the consolidated funds of the State Government after approval of the Action Plans (both state and district action plans) of the respective

Government. The financial assistance is released in two instalments; however the initial budget will be allocated as per the proposals received by the respective state.

### **INTEGRATED CHILD DEVELOPMENT SERVICES SCHEME (ICDS)**

#### **Eligibility:**

Under this scheme the children in the age group of 0-6 years and the pregnant and nursing mothers can avail the benefits on registering at the Anganwadi Centers.

#### **Financial assistance:**

Under Nutrition Programme, take-home packets of cereals and pulses are provided to pregnant women and nursing mothers (up to 6 months age of the child), and children in the age group of 06 months to 2 ½ years, through the AnganwadiCentresat the rate of Rs.12.50 per day, for pregnant lactating mothers, and Rs. 9.00 per day, per child for 300 days in a year.

The Mal-nourished children are being given special attention by referring them to Government Hospitals/GMC and providing them take home ration or cooked Nashta @ Rs. 15.00 per day/per child for 300 days in a year.

The children in the age group of 2 ½ to 6 years, attending Anganwadi centres are given hot cooked Nasta containing cereals and pulses such as, moog dal, masoor dal, gram dal, etc. The Anganwadi Centres are workingfrom8:30 AM to 12:30 PM on all days except, Sundays, second Saturdays and public holidays.

For enrolling the child at Anganwadi Centre, there is no bar or any condition domicile ,etc.

### **PRADHAN MANTRI MATRU VANDANA YOJANA**

#### **Target beneficiaries**

All pregnant Women and Lactation Mothers, excluding PW&LM who ate in regular employment with the Central Government or the State Governments or PSUs or those who are in receipt of similar benefits under any law for the time being in force. All eligible Pregnant Women and Lactating Mothers who have their Pregnancy on or after 01.01.2017 for first child in family. The date and stage of pregnancy for a beneficiary would be counted with respect to her LMP date as mentioned in the MCP card.

#### **Case of Miscarriage/Still Birth:**

- i) A beneficiary is eligible to receive benefits under the scheme only once.
- ii) In case of miscarriage/still birth, the beneficiary would be eligible to claim the remaining installment(s) in event of any future pregnancy.
- iii) Thus, after receiving the 1st installment, if the beneficiary has a miscarriage, she would only be eligible for receiving 2nd and 3rd installment in event of future pregnancy subject to

fulfillment of eligibility criterion and conditionalities of the scheme. Similarly if the beneficiary has a miscarriage or still birth after receiving 1 st and 2nd instalment, she would only be eligible for receiving 3rd installment in event of future pregnancy subject to fulfillment of eligibility criterion and conditionalities of the scheme. Case of Infant Mortality: A beneficiary is eligible to receive benefits under the scheme only once. That is, in case of infant mortality she will not be eligible for calming benefits under the scheme, if she has already received all the installment of the maternity benefit under PMMVY earlier. Pregnant and Lactating AWWs/AWHs/ASHA may also avail the benefits under the PMMVY subject to fulfilment of scheme conditionalities.

### **SCHEME FOR ADOLESCENT GIRLS (SAG) previously named RAJIV GANDHI SCHEME FOR EMPOWERMENT OF ADOLESCENT GIRLS (RGSEAG) – “SABLA”**

#### **Eligibility:**

Meant for Adolescent girls at age group of 11-14 years with focus on out-of school girls are covered in both the Districts. Financial assistance: An integrated package of services would be provided to AGs:-

- i. Nutrition provision (600 calories, 18-20 gms. of protein and micronutrients@ Rs. 9.5 per beneficiary per day for 300 days in a year and 25 days in a month).
- ii. IFA supplementation,
- iii. Health check-up and Referral services,
- iv. Nutrition & Health Education (NHE),
- v. Counselling/Guidance on family welfare, ARSH, child care practices and home management,
- vi. Life Skill Education and accessing public services,

### **INTEGRATED CHILD PROTECTION SCHEME (ICPS):**

#### **Eligibility:**

Meant for Child in need of care and protection as defined under J.J. Act 2015, child in conflict with law, vulnerable child including child from at risk families, migrant families, families in extreme poverty, children affected by HIV/AIDS, orphans, child drug abusers, child beggars, sexually exploited children, children of prisoners, street and working children, etc.

#### **Financial assistance:**

Setting up of „Open Shelters“ for children in need of care and protection, including the street children, in urban and semi-urban areas. The construction of children's home where the cost will be shared on a ratio of 60:30:10 between the Centre and the State and NGOs. The salaries of staff will be shared on a ratio of 60:30:10. The third component is the grants to be given to NGOs.

## **WORKING WOMEN'S HOSTEL:**

### **Eligibility:**

Voluntary Organizations opting to construction of hostels to provide cheap and safe accommodation to working women coming to cities from the far-off rural area **Financial assistance:**

Grants from Central Government as per project cost.

### **Universalisation of Women Helpline 181 (WHL)**

The Ministry of Women & Child Development has exclusively designed the Universal of Women Helpline Scheme of to support women affected by violence, both in private and public spaces, including in the family, community, workplace etc.

The said Women Helpline will provide 24 hour emergency response to all women affected by violence and that all the existing emergency services such as Police (100), Fire (101), Women helpline (1091), hospital /Ambulance (102), Emergency Response Services (108), NALSA Helpline for Free Legal Service (15100) and Child helpline (1098) would be integrated with this women helpline.

The Scheme of Universalisation Women Helpline 181 (WHL) shall be implemented through the concerned District Collector/ District Magistrates in the State and funds are required to be released directly to the concerned implementation agencies.

### **Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Pre-Matric Scholarship for Students belonging to ST studying in Class IXth & Xth.**

#### **Eligibility:**

- 3) She / He should not be getting any other Centrally-funded Pre-matric Scholarship.

- 5) Scholarship for studying in any class will be available for only one year. If a student has to repeat a class, she/he would not get scholarship for that class for a second (or subsequent) year.

**Assistance/Benefit under the scheme:**

- Students will be paid compulsory non-refundable fee charged by recognized institutions such as enrolment/registration, tuition, games, Union, Library, Magazine, Medical Examination and such other fees compulsorily payable by the student to the institution.

On the other hand, Airfare is given to those applicants who possess a post graduation degree in science, technical and engineering subjects. **Income Ceiling:** Total family income from all sources of the employed candidate or his/her parents/guardians or spouse should not exceed Rs. 6.00 lakh per annum (excluding such allowances as are not treated as part of total income for the purpose of income-tax) as certified by the employer. ### **VIDYA LAXMI**

The girl child who has passed 10th standard examination and gets admission in the 11th standard of any stream (Science/Arts/Commerce/Vocational/ITI) is eligible under the scheme.

All the girl children of the families notified as ST under constitutional Order and whose annual income does not exceed Rs. 3,00,000/- per annum.

### **Assistance / Benefit under the Scheme:**

An amount of Rs. 25,000/- benefit will be provided by way of fixed deposit in the name of the girl child and the Officer nominated by the Government. This amount will be given to the beneficiaries only when she passes 12th standard Board Examination or its equivalent examination on 3 attempts or within 2 years of first attempt whichever is earlier, failing which the amount sanctioned shall be forfeited and the same will be deposited in Government treasury. In case the beneficiary drop out, the money will be forfeited in favour of the Government of Goa.

Collector & SDO/Panchayat Raj Institutions/Committees constituted under Forest Right Act and Rs.80000/- (Rupees Eighty Thousand only) per financial years for conduction minimum 2 and maximum 4 activities/programmes for NGOs/Self Help group/Mahila Mandal/Youth club/sport club/sanskrutik mandal. Financial Assistance of 80% of the programme cost is provide by this Directorate and the remaining 20% should be contributed by NGOs/Self Help groups etc.

2. Any orphan child belonging to ST community who is under the care of a guardian, Viz grandparents or near relatives or in a protective home/ Dharmasala etc upto the age of 18 years.
3. Any widow who is DSS beneficiary belonging to non ST community but having minor children eligible belonging to ST community, subject to the benefit being limited to 2 children upto the age of 18 years.

Fixed maintenance allowance of Rs. 1500/- per month, per child of a widow. Fixed maintenance allowance of Rs. 2000/- per month, per child who is an orphan.

**Construction of Multipurpose Community Halls in Areas inhabited by Tribal Community “Sanskriti Bhavan”.**

**Eligibility Criteria:** Areas habited by the tribal population are classified under three classes of tribal habitations for the purpose of sanctioning community hall for the population of the villages.

Class A: The tribal areas in the village/s situated within the Forest areas where Forest Right Act is implemented.

Class B: The tribal areas in the village/ hamlet which has the habitation of tribal population for more than 40% of the population in that village/hamlet.

Class C: The areas in the villages habited by tribal population with density less than 40% of the population of the village.

**Assistance Available under the scheme:** The total cost of the project including cost of land shall not exceed Rs.2.00 crores.

1. Tribal Farmers Co-operatives registered under the cooperative societies Act and formed with the objective of improved productivity or for the marketing of the farm or forest produce
2. Committee constituted by Gram sabhas to manage Community Forest Resources under the provisions of Forest Right Act.
3. Forest Right Committees constituted under the Forest Rights Act
4. Village Panchayat in whose jurisdiction the farmers' co-operative or Committees under the Forest Rights Acts are constituted.

**Benefit under the Scheme:**

Financial Assistance will be given for running the activities for farmer's cooperatives or for the committees constituted under the Forests Rights Act:

- 1) Wages of one clerical assistant and one peon at the rates fixed under minimum wages Act. 45
- 2) Fixed amount of Rs. 25,000/- per annum for incurring expenditure on stationary, printing etc
- 3) One-time financial assistance of Rs. 1,00,000/- (One Lakh Only) for procurement of Desktop Computer, UPS, computer Table, Cupboard, Table and Chairs etc.
- 4) Rent per annum for the premises using for office purpose as per the rent certificate issued by PWD (Bldg Division), State of Goa.

- 2) Survey records & Survey Plan of the property.
- 3) Declaration that the resources will be shared.

### **Financial Assistance to Participate and Organize Exhibition cum Sale, Fairs and Workshop Camp as "Udyog Adhar Yojana"**

#### **Eligibility**

1. An Individual or a group of individuals should be of scheduled Tribe Category.
2. An individual applicant or a group should have their own capacity to produce/to make/to market the product for the purpose of exhibition cum sale.
3. NGOs working for the benefit of ST people are eligible to avail benefit under this scheme for organizing exhibition/fair/etc. for ST people to participate.

**Assistance/Benefit under the Scheme:**

- i) Financial assistance will be given to each individual/group/NGOs for the purpose of value addition in their products and for skill 47 development with the maximum limit of Rs. 1,00,000/- (One Lakh Only) per annum.
- ii) Financial assistance for Preparatory work such as to buy raw materials, making charges, labour charges etc. will be given to each individual/group/NGOs for participation in the exhibition/workshop etc. or for organizing the exhibition/fair/workshop etc. with the maximum limit of Rs. 50,000/- (fifty Thousand Only) per annum.
- iii) The actual cost of transportation, participation fees daily allowance will be given to the applicant/ group with the maximum limit of Rs.50000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) to participate in the exhibition /fair/workshop etc. per annum.
- iv) The actual cost of Organizing the exhibition/fairs/workshop etc. will be given to NGOs with maximum limit of Rs.1,00,000/- (One Lakh only) per annum for the purpose of organizing exhibition, fair, workshop etc. for ST People.
- v) 50% of the advance will be given as 1st instalment. Balance amount will be released on production of all the receipts/bills etc.

**Documents Required**

- 1) ST Certificate issued by Competent Authority.
- 2) Certificate from the Sarpanch of Village Panchayat or from the Chairperson of Municipal Council/Block Development Officer that the applicant or a group is involved personally in production or marketing of the product.
- 3) NGOs shall give their registration certificate and a detail report of the event as well as of the ST beneficiaries who will be benefitted by the exhibition/fairs/trade etc.
- 4) NGOs shall also submit two years Audit report.
- 5) Adhar Card Copy.
- 6) Estimated cost of this exhibition/fair/trade etc or estimated cost to participate in the exhibition/fair/trade etc shall be submitted.
- 7) Mandate Form & copy of bank pass book.

## **Financial Assistance to bear Medical Treatment for infertility of ST couple by IVF (Invitro Fertilization) Method Under “Matrutva Yojana”**

Eligibility:

- 1) Couples belongs to Scheduled Tribes are eligible to avail the benefits under this scheme.
- 2) There is no income limit to avail the benefit under the scheme.
- 3) Scheme is to be availed only for cases of primary infertility.

Benefit Under the scheme: - The benefit of the scheme is Rs.5,00,000/- lakhs only

## **ASHRAYA ADHAR SCHEME**

### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

(a) Any person belonging to Scheduled Tribe Community and having his house (which shall also include mundcarial house) either owned individually or jointly will be eligible for financial assistance under this scheme. In case the house is owned jointly and there are different units of the family in the same house residing separately, each such unit will be eligible for financial support under this scheme.

### **BENEFIT OF THE SCHEME:**

(a) Under this Scheme up to Rs. 500,000/- shall be advanced as financial assistance in the form of loan @ 2% simple interest per annum.

**REQUIREMENTS:** The applicant shall submit the following documents along with application form:-

- a. Scheduled Tribe Certificate (Self attested).
- b. Age proof of applicant (Birth Certificate / School Leaving Certificate / Driving License) (Self attested).
- c. Self Affidavit on Rs. 50/- Stamp Paper duly notarized.

- d. A copy of current House Tax receipt. (Original/ Attested)
- e. N.O.C from Co-owner (if any) on Rs. 50/- Stamp Paper duly notarized.
- f. Income Proof of the applicant i.e. salary certificate/ Last 03 months Pay slips along with Form 16 or last 06 months Bank Statement. Last 3 years I.T.R. along with last 06 months bank statement (Incase applicant is self-employed).
- g. Income Certificate issued by the competent authority showing the family income of applicant above Rs.1,50,000/- per annum from all sources.
- h. 02(Two) sureties with one passport photo of each surety, latest salary certificate/last three (03) months payslips along with last (06) months bank statement or Form 16 , affidavit of surety Rs. 50/- Stamp Paper duly notarized and ID proof of surety.
- i. Survey Plan along with Location Sketch.
- j. Estimated Cost of Repair/Renovation/Reconstruction of house (as per format) k. Photos of the house to be repaired.
- l. Adhar Card copy applicant (Self attested)
- m. Two passport size photos of applicant

#### **SELF EMPLOYMENT SCHEME**

##### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- i. The Scheme is exclusively for the ST Community of Goa.
- ii. The family income of the applicant / beneficiary should not be more than Rs. 1.00 Lakh per annum from all sources. However, there is relaxable in deserving cases on merit.
- iii. The age of the applicant should not be more than 55 years.

##### **Benefit of The Scheme:**

- I. Under this Scheme the financial support is advanced up to a maximum Rs. 10 Lakh in the form of loan @ 4% simple interest per annum with repayment period of 5 years to any individual person belonging to Scheduled Tribes Community to undertake any self employment activities.
- II. The Loan/Financial assistance will also be made available to the extent of Rs. 15 Lakh to the Association /Society / Partnership / Self Help Groups (SHG) / Companies formed exclusive by the member of Scheduled Tribes Community.
- III. The beneficiary is required to continue 10% margin money towards the cost project. However, the Board of Directors may relax this condition on the merit of each case. Nevertheless, this relaxation shall not be applicable to the Association / society / Partners / SHG/ Company etc.
